## FOUR COUNTY TOUR

On the morning of Saturday August 15<sup>th</sup> several of our members met with our cars at John and Lish Garnett's historic Rosemount Farm in Spotsylvania County for coffee and donuts followed by a day-long driving tour. Nick Rein, who planned the route for early model cars, led the way in his 1912 EMF. We left the farm and travelled down back country roads to our first stop at the Stonewall Jackson shrine in Caroline County.

We visited the house where Jackson died and were treated to an excellent presentation from the park ranger. We then got back in the cars and drove over 80 miles along more country roads in Hanover and Louisa counties before stopping for lunch at the Butternut and Blue Restaurant at Spotsylvania Courthouse. After lunch we walked across the street for a brief visit to the new Spotsylvania Museum. There we saw many interesting things about Spotsylvania history including a pic-

ture of the Garnett home as it looked in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Later we left the courthouse area for a little more driving and returned to the farm to see John Garnett's very fine car collection.

Everyone thanks the Garnetts for their hospitality. And we also extend a special thanks to Paul and Gretchen Carrarus from the Richmond Region. Paul and Gretchen, who are also members of the Central Virginia Model T Club, joined us on tour in their 1922 Model T. 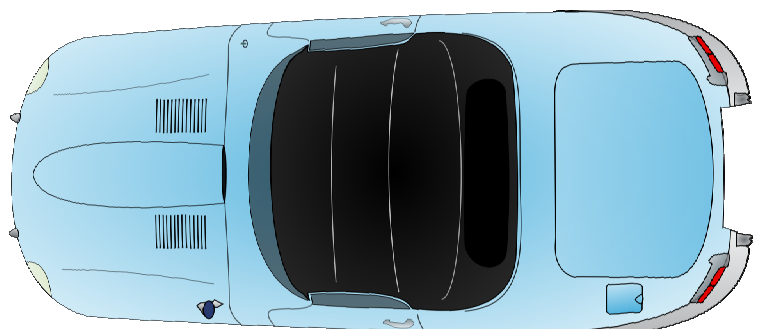
