AACA News

John mentioned that the National Website has a lot of good information about policy and procedures, forums, and registration for National events online.

The Lynchburg Region is coming back. They have about 50 members now. They will be at the ODMA meet in May. There is no one currently signed up to host the next 3 years for the ODMA meets.

Local Region Activity Planning

David Armstrong suggested that as the weather is getting better, maybe we can do a local tour with the club. David has offered to come up with a date and location.

Ball Park – Doug Makin has arranged for the club to attend ball games on May 21st and August 13th in the 3rd base skyporch. Gates open an hour before 1st pitch. \$43 per person for meal and game. We need 40 people for each game. Give checks to Doug for the May 21st game.

Memorial Bricks - John is working on the memorial bricks at the museum. The bricks have been created, but not yet laid. He may need to go to the museum.

Policy and Procedure Manual, March 2017 is available for updates. Make suggestions to John. We do need to stay in line with the National Policy and Procedures.

Fredericksburg City - J got a call from City Parks and Rec. He called to ask about our car show. J and John indicated that we have moved to the fairgrounds. They put it on the city website.

Then, they indicated to John that they want to have a car show downtown at some point. The city is willing to do all the organizing; we would only have to bring cars. John put it to the club to see if there is any interest in doing something downtown. They used to do a 4th of July display. Bill Kramer and Wally reminded the club that the city representative should come and pitch his idea to the club. Steve Blancard noted that it would be good to reestablish rapport with the city.

Upcoming Presentation - In March- a state police trooper will be here – he is in charge of inspection stations. Mark I. has indicated that we are interested in Antique tags, restrictions, trailering, etc. If you email your questions ahead of time, we can give him a list to prepare. We will let him present prior to the business meeting.

Presentation – Doug Makin

Doug received a picture of a dirty license plate and a toll from Rt 66 Express. The bill for \$25 says that Doug was driving on the I-66 HOT lanes in his antique truck. He called the company and they agreed that he was OK; it was not his car. Following that, he still received a final notice with threats. It turned out that the optical recognition of the toll lanes sometimes mix up the plates and pair with the incorrect vehicles. The photo "matched" Doug's old license plate on his truck.

It does turn out that this has happened to many other club members, including bills for different state plates.


