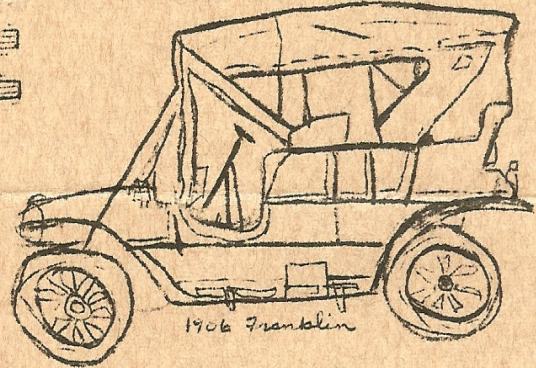
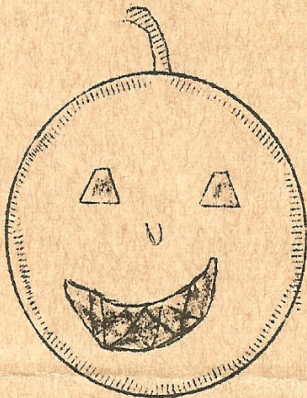


# FREDERICKSBURG ANTIQUE AUTO CLUB
